Guideline for applicants

- Applicants must be graduate students in the above-described program and must be students who will not give a research presentation in the other sessions in TGSW2017.
- Topics include: medical science, life science

Presentation style: Oral or Poster

Oral: 9-minute presentation + 3-minute discussion

Poster: Poster presentation + 2-minute talk with 1-2 slides at an oral presentation room

Abstract submission

- **Submit your entry sheet and abstract (see attached files) via email to ysuda@md.tsukuba.ac.jp**
- For the program editing, abstract will be converted into PDF without proofreading.
- Please include information of your affiliation and grade in program, and indicate: “talk” or “poster” or “no preference” in your email.
- We will contact you after the abstract deadline about the decision of your presentation style.

Awards

- Several excellent presenters will be awarded on Sept. 27. Note that the award winners of the Student Presentations Session in TGSW2015 and TGSW2016 will be excluded from the candidate.
