

Therapeutic Effects of Conservative Treatment with 2-Week Bed Rest for Osteoporotic Vertebral Fractures: A Prospective Cohort Study



We concluded that hospitalized bed rest for 2 weeks reduced the number of patients with OVF who require surgery among patients with poor prognostic MRI findings. Bed rest also reduced progression of vertebral collapse and kyphosis, regardless of the MRI findings.
