Social skills of Japanese preschool children pre- and post- COVID-19




Figure: Chi-square test showed children's social skills in 2019 were better than those in 2020

Children's social skills in 2019 were better than in 2020. Childcare institutions should support and ensure healthy child social development under the unknown duration of the COVID-19 pandemic.

Participants: Children aged 1-6 years old in childcare centers from Japan Child Care Cohort Study were recruited. Numbers of children are 1917 in 2019 and 1989 in 2020.

Process: Childcare professionals evaluated children's social skills using Social Skill Scale (SSS) in the same childcare centers, in both December 2019 and again December 2020.
